Pastor's Perspective

Life Anew!

What does post resurrection life look like? How does Christ invite us into life anew?

It was a joy to celebrate Palm Sunday and Easter with all of you and revel in the goodness of our God. Christ is Risen! He is risen indeed! This is our joyous greeting on Easter day and the words we want ringing in our ears as we venture into the days to come. What does post resurrection life look like? How does Christ invite us into life anew? This will be our question as we journey through the Easter season and into Pentecost. I'll be preaching the lectionary passages from the gospel of John (see them listed in this newsletter) and I invite you to read and pray through them throughout each week as well.

During this Easter season you and I are not only invited to live into life anew with Christ, but life anew as congregation and pastor! I am thankful that God has brought us together and look forward to getting to know each of you. I hope to do this in two ways: congregational conversation time together after the service and individual conversation as time is available. Beginning Sunday, April 3, after a brief time of fellowship after worship, I invite any of those who would so like to rejoin me in the sanctuary for a time of conversation. In these first few weeks we'll focus on getting to know one another and then we'll focus our conversation on other relevant topics.

I will be at the church on Tuesday afternoons and into evening if needed. Each Sunday I'll have a sign up sheet out if you'd like to meet at a specific time or feel free to call or email to set up a time. My contact information is below. Don't hesitate to use it!

For the women of our congregation: I will be the retreat speaker for the women of Lake Grove Presbyterian Church at Canby Grove Christian Center, April 28-May 1. There is an open invitation for the women of Springwater to join in! The theme is "Connecting with God in a World of Distraction and Change." Fee is \$225 for a private room, \$175 for shared. Dinner Friday through Sunday breakfast. The retreat ends at 12:00 on Sunday. I'll scoot over to Springwater for worship that day but you'd be welcome to take part in the whole thing. SPC Buildings and Grounds Committee current actions include:

- Determining costs of repairing the Manse roof that was damaged by winter winds and finding out what repairs our insurance co. may cover.
- Looking for names of painting contractors as we start planning to re-paint the exterior of our building.
- Developing a list of projects for our 'annual Spring clean-up day". Date to be announced soon.
- Discussing timing of completing other maintenance needs such as resealing the parking lot, repairing doors in the church, and work in our outdoor worship areas and labyrinth area.

Projects for Our Renters

The Buildings and Grounds Committee now serves as our church's Property Manager for the manse with Gilbert Shibley being the contact person for our renters. Two recent projects there will serve as preventative maintenance.

In February two young men from Springwater were hired to cut and pull English ivy so a local tree service company could do a light pruning for us of the big maple in the front yard. It needed a few dead branches and several low-hanging ones removed. After two other inspections by professionals the consensus was that the tree has no hazardous defects and no structural reason for taking it down.

In March the big pot hole in the driveway to the manse was fixed by digging to improve drainage, filling and packing with existing rock and then adding two cubic yards of new crushed rock. This had been an accumulating need over a five year span. Gilbert was able to get it done using his farm tractor and truck.

We will be feeding the homeless on Sunday, April 10th this month. If there is anyone who would like to help pre-bake the potatoes, blanch broccoli, or show up to help serve the meal, sign up at the church or contact Debbie Ingamells, 503 313-9575.

The Presbytery of the Cascades is hosting the PC(USA) General Assembly. From the GA website:


